

Building Use Criteria

Revised: November 22, 2021

General Policy

- Masks are to be worn in the building at all times – except when eating /drinking
- Social distancing is to be observed – we ask everyone to maintain a 3-foot separation

Meetings

- Adhere to the **General Policy** indicated above
- Meetings still have to be scheduled
- Meetings shall not be held when the Preschool is present
- Meetings are encouraged to use Room 215
- All regular groups including Committees, Boy Scouts, AA and HOAs may have meetings

Use of Building for Committee Activities

- Adhere to the **General Policy** indicated above
- Use of the building for activities (such as decorating the sanctuary, preparing for the Live Nativity, preparing for a bake sale, preparing for lunch for the Lamb Center) are okay
- These activities must not interfere with the Preschool
- Use of the kitchen is okay

Cup of Fellowship

- Adhere to the **General Policy** indicated above
- The congregation can return to the fellowship hall after the service
- It was noted at recent services that the congregation gathered in the Narthex and it became crowded. By opening up the Fellowship Hall, we would be promoting a safer situation

Regular Sanctuary Services

- Adhere to the **General Policy** indicated above
- Eliminate the requirement to sign-up
- Change the “taped off” restrictions to 3-foot distances
- Retain overflow in the Fellowship Hall
- When the choir members return to the choir loft, they will be spaced apart and may sing without a mask if they jointly decide to do so

Christmas Eve Services

- Adhere to the **General Policy** indicated above
- Use all pews
- Restrict Sanctuary attendance to a specific number to be determined
- Overflow will be in the Fellowship Hall
- Choir members will sing with a mask

Weddings and Funerals

- Adhere to the **General Policy** indicated above
- Restrict Sanctuary attendance to a specific number (probably 60 people – as for Christmas Eve services)
- Overflow will be in the Fellowship Hall
